## Who is eligible?

Future elementary and middle school teachers who have a connection to their community.

## Entry requirements

Completion of both of the following by December 2021:

- ▶ Associate's degree in elementary education or AGEC-A (Arizona General Education Curriculum) with 60 transferrable units.
- ▶ University of Arizona College of Education elementary education program prerequisites.

## Meet with an advisor from the College of Education

Meet with an advisor from our elementary education program to review unofficial transcripts. This does not obligate you or guarantee entrance in the Pathways to Teaching Program. Rather, it provides you with information about how you might apply completed coursework to the program as well as information about courses you may need to take before applying.

## Benefits

- ▶ Earn a degree in elementary education (K-8 teaching) from the University of Arizona College of Education with English as a Second Language endorsement.
- ▶ Full tuition\* covered through Arizona Teachers Academy.
- ▶ Receive a monthly stipend of \$1,000.
- ▶ Hands-on experience with an experienced classroom mentor teacher in classrooms.
- ▶ University of Arizona classes offered at a local school site.
- ▶ 17-month program (January 2022 to May 2023), including summer.
- ▶ Graduation in May 2023!
- ▶ An additional year for special education certification
