AIDE CAREGIVER

Purpose Statement:

The job of AIDE CAREGIVER is done for the purpose/s of assisting in the supervision and instruction of infants and students; performing classroom clerical tasks; assisting children in meeting health care needs and developing children's daily living skills.

This job reports to PRINCIPAL AND STUDENT SERVICES DIRECTOR

Essential Functions

- Administers, under supervision, first aid and assistance to medically fragile children (e.g. tube feeding, toileting, diapering, etc.) for the purpose of providing appropriate care and/or developing children's daily living activities and behavioral skills.
- Assists infants and students as requested by program goals (e.g. feeding, changing diapers, etc.) for the purpose of providing appropriate care to children and maintaining a quiet infant sleep area.
- · Cleans work areas (e.g. changing tables, cribs, sinks, linens, etc.) for the purpose of maintaining a sanitary environment.
- Maintains child care facilities for the purpose of ensuring a sanitary and safe environment for infants and toddlers.
- Serves breakfast, lunch and/or snacks for the purpose of meeting children's nutritional needs.

Other Functions

- Administers first aid to children as may be required under direct superivsion of certified staff member for the purpose of meeting immediate health care needs.
- Implements behavioral plans under direct supervision of certified staff members for the purpose of meeting child's social and daily living skills.
- Organizes indoor/outdoor, quiet/active play activities appropriate to age group for the purpose of actively participating with children on scheduled hours and days.
- Performs other related duties, as assigned, for the purpose of ensuring the efficient and effective functioning of the work unit.
- Receives and delivers children directly from/to parents or designee for the purpose of ensuring safety of children and meeting district requirements.

Job Requirements: Minimum Qualifications

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities

SKILLS are required to perform single, non-technical tasks using existing skills. Specific skills required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: promoting child centered environment.

KNOWLEDGE is required to perform basic math; read and follow instructions; and understand written and oral instructions. Specific knowledge required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job includes: age appropriate activities, bilingual (english/spanish) helpful

ABILITY is required to schedule activities; collate data; and consider a number of factors when using equipment. Flexibility is required to work with others; work with data utilizing specific, defined processes; and operate equipment using a variety of standardized methods. Ability is also required to work with a diversity of individuals; work with specific, job-related data; and utilize a variety of job-related equipment. In working with others, Problem solving with data requires following prescribed guidelines; and problem solving with equipment is limited. Specific abilities required to satisfactorily perform the functions of the job include: adapting to changing work priorities creating and maintaining climate of respect, maintaining confidentiality, working as part of a team.

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Responsibility

Responsibilities include: working under limited supervision following standardized practices and/or methods; providing information and/or advising others; and operating within a defined budget. Utilization of some resources from other work units may be required to perform the job's functions. There is some opportunity to effect the Organization's services.

Working Environment

The usual and customary methods of performing the job's functions require the following physical demands: significant lifting, carrying, pushing, and/or pulling; frequent climbing and balancing; frequent stooping, kneeling, crouching, and/or crawling; and significant fine finger dexterity. Generally the job requires 0% sitting, 25% walking, and 75% standing. The job is performed under a generally hazard free environment.
